DESCRIPTION

Remastered and presented here with new artwork. A forest isn't something normally associated with noise; it brings to mind silence and solitude. However, the ominous cover art here - and the artists within - bring to mind the notorious suicide forest Aokigahara. Despite all tracks falling into the Japanese genre, the tracks are very diverse, yet every track is so distinct it could only be by that artist.
