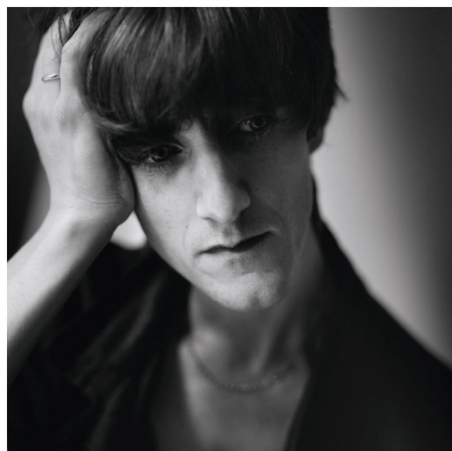

DESCRIPTION

35th Anniversary edition of the seminal 1989 **Durutti Column** album *Vini Reilly*. Produced by **Stephen Street** (**The Smiths**, **Blur**, **The Cranberries**, **New Order**). Remastered and heavily expanded five-disc version, featuring over 75 tracks. Disc 1 features the *Vini Reilly* album plus three bonus tracks. The original album is presented in the famous (and as to now unseen) "rejected" sleeve by **8vo**. Disc 2 features *The Sporadic Recordings* (28 tracks), a limited-edition CD from 1989. Disc 3 features *Womad Live* EP, plus bonus live tracks and demos (16 tracks). Disc 4 is an exclusive DVD, *Live from Porto 1988*. Disc 5 features a bonus one-track 3" mini-CD titled *I Know Very Well How I Got My Name*, a replica of the bonus addition from the original CD pressing. Expansive booklet includes new essay by Durutti Column/Factory Records expert **James Nice**, liner notes by band member **Bruce Mitchell**, liner notes from **Anthony Wilson**, interview extracts with Vini Reilly and restored images and outtake images.
