DESCRIPTION

Zwei Frankfurter Préludes (Two Frankfurt Préludes) presents a live recording of the two première given on November 19, 1999 with the **hr Sinfonieorchester** conducted by **Arturo Tamayo**. The titles of these works are nearly identical ("Two Cranes and Clouds" and "Two Cranes and Clouds / Double") and are conceptually related, though they could hardly be more different. One is based on an extreme accumulation of density over about a minute and a half, while the other explores a radical expansion in both time and space. Each work is scored for large orchestra and the second of them, which lasts some 50 minutes, positions the musicians along a diagonal line that bisects the performance space.
