DESCRIPTION

A key funk release from 1971, For The People was the second album by interracial soul-rock band led by vocalist **Milt Matthews**. All the way from Wilson, North Carolina, Milton Ray Matthews was an inspired songwriter in the vein of master **Curtis Mayfield** and follower **Lou Bond**.
