Cathy Berberian turned toward this repertoire critically, but with love. And even if she maintained a certain dose of ironic distance, she never stooped to parody. It would be a mistake to think she had any similarity to **Paolo Poli** in *La Nemica*. She had a repertoire to explore according to the instructions of **Proust**, and she explored it with the same devotion that she had applied to the music of **Berio** or **Bussotti**. In this recital she explores the most varied vocal territories: from traditional songs to Berio and to . . . **The Beatles**. In addition to compositions by **Kurt Weill, William Walton**, and herself. In this labyrinthine voice is a release for all vocals lovers.
