DESCRIPTION

In 1972, left-wing intellectual film critic **Uwe Nettelbeck** suggested to **Anthony Moore** that he might write some straight songs (relatively speaking), which in turn prompted Moore to invite his old school friend **Peter Blegvad** over to Hamburg to form the band **Slapp Happy**. **Dagmar Krause**, a young singer from Hamburg and Moore's girlfriend, joined them both on their trip to Wümme to record what was to become this album, *Sort Of*, using **Faust** as their rhythm section. In honor of this album's 50th anniversary the album will get a nicely remastered reissue with the newly founded Week-End Records – the festival's inhouse label who managed to get the band together for a final reunion shows in November of 2016 and Spring of 2017.
